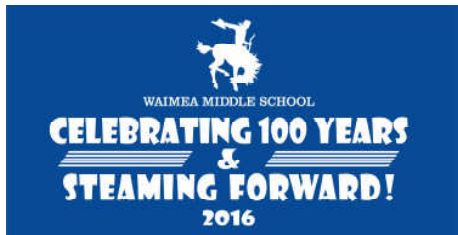

- **Introductory Hawaiian w/ Cara Bertelmann** – Tuesdays & Thursdays, 3-4:30 p.m. K-04. Basic vocabulary, sentence patterns and sayings.
- **Mini Mermaids - A Girls Running Club w/ Kit Hill** - Wednesdays, 1:30-3:30 p.m. L-02. To introduce healthy life choices, build self-esteem and trusting friendships through movement and conversations. Limited to 10 students – first come.
- **Hands-On-Science w/ Matt Binder** - Tuesdays & Thursdays, 3-4:30 p.m. P-11. Learn to think like a scientist and, in the process, discover that science is fascinating and fun! Students will contribute to a citizen-scientist project called iNaturalist and will capture and study mosquitoes to identify them, learn about their habits and life cycle, and photograph them with a macro-lens using an iPad. And Mr. Binder will use his big bag of scientific tricks to help students answer all sorts of questions about science from astronomy to zoology, biology, aeronautics, chemistry, electromagnetism, geology and physics.
- **Introductory Sewing w/ Iris Thompson**– Mondays, 2:30-5 p.m. P4. Learn sewing basics by making items using sewing machines as well as hand work. Fabric will be provided for the first project; students/families are asked to provide preferred fabrics for additional class projects. Both boys and girls welcome; limited to 6 students.
- **Become An Artist! w/ Geoffrey Mundon** - Mondays, 2:30-4 p.m. & Wednesdays, 1;30-3 p.m.. L-03A. Learn basic art skills, how to use various art media (pencils, paints, etc.), how to make their own art supplies out of recycled materials including creating their own sketch book, and they will participate in a field trip to an artist's studio to see many different kinds of art to get ideas that inspire their own art projects.
